In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Physiotherapist** in the HSE.

1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Candidates for appointment must possess:

- (i) The B.Sc (Honours) degree in Physiotherapy from the University of Dublin*

*The award granted after completing the four year study programme in the University of Dublin.
- (ii) Degree of Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Physiotherapy, National University of Ireland, Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland.
- (iii) Degree of Bachelor of Physiotherapy (Honours) Degree from University College Dublin, National University of Ireland.
- (iv) Honours Degree Bachelor of Science (Physiotherapy) from University College Dublin, National University of Ireland, Dublin.
- (v) The BSc (Honours) Degree in Physiotherapy from the University of Limerick
- (vi) Master of Science Physiotherapy (Pre-Registration) from University College Dublin, National University of Ireland, Dublin.
- (vii) Professional Master of Physiotherapy from University College Dublin
- (viii) M.Sc Physiotherapy from the University of Limerick
- (ix) The Diploma in Physiotherapy of the University of Dublin or the National University of Ireland.
- (x) A non-Irish Physiotherapy qualification recognised by CORU or the Irish Society of Chartered Physiotherapists.
