Regulatory Functions

How does CORU regulate Health and Social Care Professionals?

CORU protects the public by regulating health and social care professionals in Ireland. It does this by setting standards for professional practice and by maintaining statutory registers that control who can practise using a protected professional title.

Being registered with CORU means that a professional has met the required standards for education, competence, and ethical practice, and is subject to ongoing regulation while they remain on the register.
